School Picture Retakes


School picture retakes will be on Wednesday, November 16th. If you would like your child(ren) to retake their picture please let the school office know.

The Archangels Youth Group

St Michael, St Gabriel and St Raphael are the Archangels named in the Bible.

They praise and worship God before His throne and take special care of God's people.

We especially pray for their special protection of our children.

Our Youth Group's use their namesake and ask for their guidance and protection.

The Archangel Gabriel is God's messenger from heaven, and the name 'Gabriel' means "God is my strength".

Gabriel appeared to Zechariah to announce the birth of John the Baptist. He also appeared to the Blessed Virgin Mary with the greeting "Hail, full of grace". He announced to Mary that she was to be the Mother of God.

*We use his namesake for special protection of our youth in Grades K-4. We ask Gabriel to help us listen to God's word.

The Archangel Raphael is God's healer (means "God has healed"). Raphael appeared to a young man named Tobias, led him to his future wife, and then ordered Tobias to catch a fish to make medicine from it. We ask Raphael for God's healing of our bodies and souls.

*We use Raphael's namesake and ask special protection of our youth in Grades 5-8. We ask Raphael's special prayers for these youth before the throne of God.

St Raphael, the Archangel

The Archangel Michael is the prince of the angels. The name Michael means: "Who is like God?" (because no one is equal to God). Michael led the good angels in the great battle against the Devil and the fallen angels. Michael defeated the Devil and cast all the fallen angels out of heaven. He defends the Church against the Devil and all evil spirits.

*We use Michael's namesake for our youth in Grades 9-12. We pray for Michael's guidance and protection for these youth as they grow to become faithful young adults who will follow our Lord.




