Registration night is Wednesday, September 9, 2026. Registration will take place in the church dining hall. After registering your child/ren, please go upstairs. Once all the families have registered we will have a short introduction and the children will go to their classroom with their teacher/s.

2026-27 School Year:

The CCD 26-27 Calendar has several Wednesdays that are "Large Group and Class-All Grades Attend," those evenings parents with their child/ren in grades K-6 go to church. At 6:30 pm an introduction and prayer is held. Children will be excused to go to their classroom with their Catechists. The parents remain in church and Father Alan will give a series of talks called Catholicism 101"

PLEASE NOTE: Wednesday, October 14, 2026 all students in grades K-10 need to attend CCD for safe environment training.

When there is not a Large Group and Class-All Grades Attend, then Grades K-1, 3-6 are encouraged to attend. Grades 2, 7, 8, 9, and 10 are required to attend every CCD night. Any questions, please email or call me.

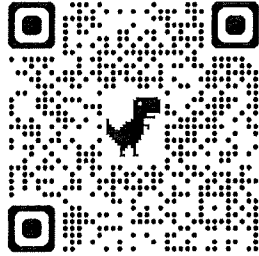
Enclosed are several items for you to read and fill out prior to registration night.

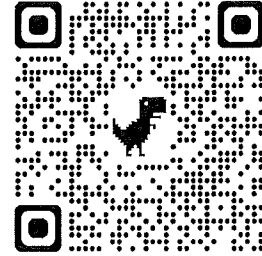
Second, Verification of Parent Safe Environment Training (green sheet, form #4). This sheet needs to be filled out and turned in.

Dear Parent or Guardian,

St. John the Baptist Parish will be presenting Protect and Heal Safe Environment Lessons to all children enrolled in St. John's CCD Program. This training is offered in response to the mandates of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People: Promise to Protect, Pledge to Heal. The Protect and Heal Program was developed by the Diocese of La Crosse by the Office of Catechesis and Office of Youth Ministry as its curriculum to help keep our children safe.

This training will help your child/ren recognize unhealthy relationships, appropriate ways to reduce the likelihood of being abused, and how to get help from others. Most importantly, this information will be presented to your child in a manner that reinforces his/her value as a person created in the image and likeness of God deserving of love and respect. Everyone, especially children, deserve a safe environment to learn and worship.

Your child's training session will be held on Wednesday, October 14th at 6:30 pm in the classroom where he/she has a CCD class by his or her teacher. Each training has its own video and/or PDF lesson. On the form you can read what is taught in each grade. If you would like to see the PDF lesson plan, visit <https://diolc.org/safe-environment/library/> and click on the grade/s your child/ren are in.

Each child will be Safe Environment trained unless the enclosed Diocese of La Crosse Declination form is completed and returned. It is important for us to have your signed consent or refusal on file. Emailed or phoned responses are not acceptable. Please note that if we do not receive this form back by Tuesday, October 13th, we will allow your child to participate in the training session.

Verification of Protect and Heal Training

Diocese of La Crosse



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The Diocese of La Crosse provides *Protect and Heal* training FROM THE CATHOLIC PERSPECTIVE to participating individuals in its programs.

The substance and focus of *Protect and Heal* training is as follows:

Kindergarten-Second Grade: Students will learn about their **dignity** (their incredible worth) as **children of God** and the respect that each person deserves as a child of God. Students will learn about safety, safe environment and the care that surrounds them, the difference between appropriate, kind actions and behavior that makes them feel safe, secure and loved, and inappropriate, harmful actions and behaviors that make them feel uncomfortable or unsafe.

Grade Three-Five: Students will learn about the virtue of **respect**, which is based upon the **dignity of each human person**. Students will learn the importance of saying "no" to inappropriate, harmful actions, behavior and touch that makes them feel uncomfortable or unsafe. Children will be encouraged to tell immediately a trusted adult when these situations arise and will learn about the buddy system.

Grade Six-Eight: Students will learn about how each person, including themselves, must be treated with **respect**. Students will learn about, and seek to develop or further develop, the virtue of **prudence**-making good decisions. Students will learn practical tips for keeping themselves safe and will discuss defensive and assertive body language to protect themselves.

High School: Students will understand virtue, which are **good moral habits**, and vice, which are bad moral habits. Students will discuss the virtue of **chastity** and **modesty**; learn practical steps for protecting themselves and others from sexual abuse, including the ability to recognize warning signs and how to react to abuse and to the possible threat of abuse.
